



RU-1 is a Single-Family Residential Zoning District.

Zoning Restrictions:


- Maximum height: building shall be 35 feet, two stories
- Fences, Walls, & Hedges: Max Height- 6ft. Except 2.5' within sight visibility triangles at intersections and driveways.
- Projections and architectural elements: that do not add habitable interior space to a building can extend 5ft above the limited height.
- Active and passive recreational facilities: may be provided on the roof of a building, provided that the enclosed portion of such facilities shall not exceed sixty (60) percent of the total area of such roof.






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
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TYPICAL HOUSING LAYOUT







On Arterial road- Old Culter rd- the speed limit ranges from 35 to 45 mph depend on the density of the residential areas along the road.



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- Rehabilitation centers are often designed monumentally; not by size but memory and lifestyle
- Architecture can be the thing that heals, distracts, comforts, protects and even motivates someone to want to heal and push past the tough movements they will face.
- Architecture that heals in a way strives to achieve the physical embodiment of Maslow's pyramid (McLeod. S, 2007).
- The architecture needs to facilitate optimal physical activity, human engagement, and psychological reactions.
- "Rehabilitation does not repair or undo the damage caused by illness or trauma; rather, it aids in the restoration of an individual's health, efficiency, and well-being."
- Some things that rehabilitative architecture should be:
 - Stimulating, friendly, safe, and easily accessible
 - Mix of private and public spaces
 - Encourage and promote achievement and inspiration
 - Connection to nature
 - Environmental engagement helps with loneliness and anxiety
- Appeal to the senses:
 - Texture
 - Color
 - Material
 - Even water (sounds)




